Although the differential diagnosis is broad, a detailed history and physical examination can narrow the diagnosis (Table 1) Appropriate treatment can begin only after correct diagnosis The primary care sports medicine physician can manage most conditions that cause anterior knee pain in the active individual However, there are occasions
