THE HIEROGLYPHIC ALPHABET

Hieroglyphs are visual representations of real or imaginary elements This particular set has been simplified for ease of use It corresponds closely to the more complicated heiroglyphs, but makes those glyphs easier for beginners to draw Hieroglyphs can function in a variety of ways 1 As a phonogram - the sign is read as it sounds 2

The Evolution of Egyptian Hieroglyphs

For many years, no one knew how to read hieroglyphs anymore Then, in 1799, the Rosetta Stone was discovered On this stone, a speech by the Egyptian king Ptolemy V from 196 BC had been written down The same text was written in three languages, once in Greek, once in hieroglyphics and once in another Egyptian script called demotic Demotic
